

BAS/BLS IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGE GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

A limited number of scholarships for \$1,000 to be used toward tuition and/or fees for Bachelor of Applied Studies or Bachelor of Liberal Studies students are available. To be eligible for the scholarship, the student must be a graduate of an Iowa Community College Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), or Associate in Applied Science (AAS) program and be admitted to the BAS or BLS program. Typically, the scholarship is only awarded once during a student's enrollment in the BAS or BLS program, though he or she may also apply for the Division of Continuing Education Scholarship. If the funds for the scholarship are not used completely in the Fall session, they may be carried over into the Spring or Summer session. However, the student must be registered for any Summer session course by June 1 in order to receive funds from the scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY:

- You must be admitted to either the Bachelor of Applied Studies or Bachelor of Liberal Studies program by **July 1** of the year of application for this scholarship.
- You must be a graduate of an Iowa Community College Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), or Associate in Applied Science (AAS) program.
- You must use the scholarship for tuition and/or fees in coursework offered by The University of Iowa.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Please answer all questions. Applications must be complete in order to be considered.
- The deadline for receipt of applications is **July 1**, and the BAS/BLS Iowa Community College Graduate Scholarship only is awarded once per year prior to the Fall session.
- Scholarships are awarded prior to the Fall session. Any unused portion of the scholarship can be deferred to the Spring and/or Summer session, though students must register by June 1 to use the award in Summer.
- You must submit a new application form for each year that you wish to be considered for a scholarship, but students typically only receive the BAS/BLS Iowa Community College Graduate Scholarship once.
