

65th Annual Labor Short Course

Week-long intensive course for lowa union members, designed to educate and equip newer activists with essential skills, and update and reinvigorate experienced leaders. Presented by The University of Iowa Labor Center in cooperation with the Iowa Federation of Labor, AFL-CIO. Topics will include:

- Labor Movement Basics: Labor history, union values, present and future challenges
- Leadership Skills: Communications, grievance handling, organizing, planning effective meetings
- Legal Tools: Labor and collective bargaining law (private and public sectors), and workplace laws including FMLA, ADA, Workers' Compensation
- **Building the Future:** Key economic and policy debates; local and global struggles; race, immigration and labor rights; and more
